BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PANDORA-GILBOA LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. The Board approves the retention of the law firms of Scott Scriven LLP and Dinsmore (the "Firms") for advice and assistance in matters relating to school law and worker's compensation as may be requested from time to time by the District Superintendent, Treasurer, or Board President. Such services may include legal advice and representation in court or otherwise on such requested matters. The Board shall pay the Firms reasonable fees for services rendered, plus out-of-pocket disbursements by the Firm, such as out-of-county travel expenses, large-project copying costs, and long-distance telephone charges.

Section 2. In rendering such legal services, as an independent contractor and in an attorney-client relationship, the Firms shall not exercise any administrative discretion on behalf of this Board in the formulation of public policy; the expenditure of public funds, or in the enforcement of any laws, rules, and regulations of the State, any county, cities, other political subdivisions, or of this Board; or the execution of public trusts.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
